Ready Set GO!....Prepare your team for Chariots of Fire 2018



On behalf of the official recipient charity this year, Cambridge Community Foundation, thank you for entering a team in Chariots of Fire on Sunday 16th September.

This year all funds and donations are supporting the Cambridgeshire Community Foundation's High Sheriff Awards Fund. By fundraising for this cause you will help provide opportunities that give local young people an appetite to achieve more for themselves, and perhaps set the young person off in a new direction.

Many local young people face real difficulties because of poor mental health, bereavement, long term illness or disability. Others have limited support and opportunity to develop and flourish because of the low aspirations or very limited income of their families. The Cambridge Community Foundation's High Sheriff's Awards funds projects that seek to help such young people to engage in positive activities which develops their skills and confidence.

Team entry deadlines

The popularity of Chariots of Fire remains as strong as ever and this year, the team capacity is 400. The closing date for team entries is **Wednesday 12th September** at 5pm or when team numbers reach 400, whichever is soonest.

On the day registration

If you are the assigned team manager, on Sunday 16th September, you will need to register your team at the registration marquee on Queens' Green between 7.30am and 9.00am to collect your running pack containing your team running numbers, t-shirts, safety pins and baton. The race will start promptly at 9.30am.

Where to meet your team(s)

As Queens' Green becomes very congested during the morning of the race to assist you in meeting up with the other members of your team there are dedicated meeting zones marked out amongst the Green. Team meeting zones are organised according to Team number, as listed below.
